Being a foreign student from a poor country, she'd had many difficult experiences with the visa and immigration department. She'd been turned away repeatedly because of missing documents. To extend her student visa for another year felt like the way of the cross to her. Yet again some document seemed to be missing. She was turned away coldly and with an arrogant gaze. She left the building in tears. She'd not understood what document was missing. She remembered her motto: Don't give up. She composed herself and went back into the building. This time the case worker was a lot friendlier and it turned out that she had all the documents required.

A young Canaan mother whose daughter had fallen ill had made a similar experience. She needed help. The young woman had heard of Jesus. She went to see him and -in all her despair and distress- cried out for help. Jesus reacted harshly and unsympathetic, because he was taking care of his Jewish people.
