## Dear friends of go4peace,

she was young and she had fallen in love, head over heels. Of course, she and her lover wanted to spend time together. This was happening despite an already existing marriage. The scribes and pharisees had caught them in the act. The dragged her in front of Jesus, who was teaching in the temple grounds. It was now a matter of life and death.

Jewish law was calling for death by stoning in these circumstances. She was full of fear – helpless and dependent. Would Jesus be on her side, and go against the law?
