But instead of taking his shopping home, he got carried along by the crowd. They were following a young Rabbi called Jesus. His words were full of life and everyone liked to listen to him. Then it was time to eat. Instead of sending the people home, the young Rabbi took care of it himself.

Only if everyone began to share, could the crowd be fed. Here our little boy was first in line. Everything he'd just bought he gave away, his five loaves of bread and 2 fish. He covered all the teenagers in his vicinity and got absolutely drenched himself. I can still remember his glowing eyes! He was happy to have shared what he could. – **I'll give you what I have!**
