And yet, with every decision, uncertainty remains in us; especially for those of us who need a high degree of certainty to make a decision.

Jesus knew this. So he lets his friends understand: "I am the way and the truth and the life!" In doing so, he invites us to trust the path that brings us into life. He gives us the courage to keep at it even in difficult phases and to keep going, because HE is the path on which we are travelling. This can give us great serenity and confidence, and at the same time the courage to make decisions even if we only have 70% or 80% certainty. "Let us trust life, because God lives it with us!" Alfred Delp encourages his contemporaries in difficult times. It's only when I've made up my mind and go out that I find the truth for my own life.
